

George N. Gilbert

Since February, 1988, George has been **Director of Elections** to the Guilford County Board of Elections. It is a jurisdiction of more than 355,000 registered voters and includes the cities of Greensboro and High Point, North Carolina. During his 21 years in this position, George has administered more than 60 elections using four different electronic voting systems.

George is a nationally Certified Election/Registration Administrator (CERA) through the Election Center and Auburn University. He also is a State Certified Election Administrator in North Carolina. He served during 2001 and 2005 on the Election Center's Ad Hoc Task Force on Election Law Reform and Co-chairs the Legislative Committee of the National Association of Election Officials.

Prior to entering his present position, Mr. Gilbert worked in a family owned business in north Florida, where he was born and raised.

From 1976 - 1982 he was a Legislative Assistant in the **United States Senate**. This service was preceded by two years as a research assistant in the **Congressional Research Service** in the Library of Congress in Washington, D. C.

George studied economics at the University of Florida and Florida State University, earning his Masters degree in 1976.

He married the Reverend Carol Williams-Gilbert of Greensboro in 1987 and moved to North Carolina. They have two children, Caroline (18) and Wesley (15).
