COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

August 2023

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. In August 2023, the Committee responded to almost 1,800 phone calls and email messages seeking advice, and participated in many informal meetings with Members, House staff, and outside individuals or groups regarding specific ethics matters. The Committee also received 28 requests for formal advisory opinions.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 118th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 155 new travel requests in August 2023 for travel beginning in August or later. Three hundred and sixty-four House employees traveled on a Committee-approved, privately-sponsored, officially-connected trip within the month of August.

The Committee is required under House rules to offer mandatory annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. The Committee is working to modernize its guidance in both substance and method of delivery. The Committee continued to provide training in August through live and on-demand offerings. Sixty-five individuals attended the live in-person Ethics training hosted by the Committee on August 22. Seventeen individuals also attended live virtual training provided by the Committee at the request of one office. The calendar of live in-person training opportunities is available here.

As part of an effort to better promote compliance through clear and effective guidance, the Committee, together with the Committee on House Administration and the Communications Standards Commission, issued Joint Guidance Relating to Natural and National Disasters on August 15. The Joint Guidance Relating to Natural and National Disasters is available here. Prior general advisories and pink sheets are available here.

The Committee released no public statements in August 2023. Prior public statements are available here.

The Committee issued a summary of its activities for July 2023 directed to the Committee on House Administration. This statement is publicly available on the Committee on House Administration's website.
