Oversight Activities:

- Meetings
  - Continued consistent, recurring oversight meetings with institutional stakeholders on a bipartisan basis.
  - Continued exploration and engagement with service providers to broaden House's understanding of potential technology and tools to increase staff capacity and effectiveness in serving the American people.
- Noteworthy Events:
  - CRS Director has been re-assigned, leading to new temporary Director being appointed. The Committee is supportive of this leadership change and looks forward to partnering with CRS as it continues its service to Congress.
  - House Superintendent resigned. The Committee is actively partnering with the Acting AOC, Chere Rexroat, to support the continued staff changes taking place throughout the organization.
  - Partnered with institutional partners to ensure the health and safety of congressional workers (AOC, USCP, HSAA) during days of high smoke intensity outdoors due to the Canadian wildfires.
- Letters:
  - Received: formal approval of request for a GAO STAA Detail to assist the Committee in its work supporting the House's internal development of an AI policy and overall awareness of the technological advancements related to AI. Detail to begin June 26, 2023.
  - Approved extension of USBG hours for corpse flower blooms expected throughout summer 2023
  - Approved Billy Graham National Statuary Hall Statue for next step in process

### Elections Activities:

- Election University 101: Introduction to the Constitution. This briefing focused on an essential understanding of the U.S. Constitution, focusing on the structure and functions of the government and the rights afforded to U.S. citizens. Topics discussed include the Bill of Rights and other amendments, the division of power among the three branches of government, federal and state jurisdiction, and a Q&A session for deeper understanding.
- Election University 201: This briefing covered the various types of equipment used to administer elections, including electronic and paper-based voting systems, ballot processing and tabulation equipment, and electronic poll-books.
- Election University 301: The briefing focused on security protocols, cybersecurity devices, and physical security measures election officials have in place to protect the integrity of our country's elections equipment and infrastructure. In this session, we will also discuss the roles of the EAC (U.S. Election Assistance Commission) and CISA (the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency, part of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security) in maintaining election security.

### Modernization Activities:

- Continued stakeholder engagement with internal and external partners, and on a bipartisan basis, regarding recommendation implementation and identification of further modernization initiatives to be explored.
- House formally entered into contract with an eDiscovery platform for committee use.
- Kicked off engagement with stakeholders across all levels of the legislative process to begin identifying areas for improving the system, its effectiveness, transparency, and reliability.
