- August 11, 2021—Letter to the Honorable Charles Rettig, Commissioner, Internal Revenue Service, requesting a review of the non-profit tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of Grand Canyon University, which is a converted non-profit institution of higher education.
- August 11, 2021—Letter to the Honorable Charles Rettig, Commissioner, Internal Revenue Service, requesting a review of the non-profit tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of University of Arizona Global Campus, which is a converted non-profit institution of higher education.
- August 16, 2021—Letter to the Honorable Miguel Cardona, Secretary, U.S. Department of Education, requesting a review of the authority granted under the *Higher Education Act* that permits the Secretary to pursue personal liability for debts owed by institutions against the owners and executives of those institutions.
- August 23, 2021—Letter to Michale McComis, Executive Director, Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges (ACCSC), requesting information about ACCSC’s reported accreditation of 2 institutions—University of Northern New Jersey and University of Farmington—as part of two sting operations run by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.
- August 23, 2021—Letter to The Honorable Martin Walsh, Secretary, U.S. Department of Labor, submitting comments supporting the Department’s proposed rule published June 23, 2021, regarding use of the tip credit for workers performing “dual jobs” under the *Fair Labor Standards Act*. This was a joint letter with Subcommittee on Workforce Protections Chair Alma Adams and Representatives Mark Takano, Suzanne Bonamici, and Pramila Jayapal.
