COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

October 2023

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. In October 2023, the Committee responded to over 1,200 phone calls and email messages seeking advice, and participated in many informal meetings with Members, House staff, and outside individuals or groups regarding specific ethics matters. The Committee also received 32 requests for formal advisory opinions.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 118th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 241 new travel requests in October 2023 for travel beginning in October or later. Two-hundred and forty-three House employees traveled on a Committee-approved, privately-sponsored, officially-connected trip within the month of October.

The Committee is required under House rules to offer mandatory annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. The Committee is working to modernize its guidance in both substance and method of delivery. The Committee continued to provide training in October through live and on-demand offerings. Twenty-three individuals attended the live in-person Ethics training hosted by the Committee on October 22. Seventeen individuals also attended live training provided by the Committee at the request of one office. The calendar of live in-person training opportunities is available here.

As part of an effort to better promote compliance through clear and effective guidance, the Committee, together with the Committee on House Administration, issued a Pink Sheet detailing Joint Guidance on Capitol Flag Flying Program on October 12. The Joint Guidance on Capitol Flag Flying Program is available here. Prior general advisories and pink sheets are available here.

Pursuant to Committee Rule 7, the Committee released one public statement regarding Representative George Santos in October 2023. The Statement of the Chair and Ranking Member regarding Rep. Santos is available here. Prior public statements are available here.
