- August 12, 2022—H.R. 5376, the *Inflation Reduction Act of 2022*, sponsored by Rep. Yarmuth (KY), on a motion that the House agree to the Senate amendment, passed the House by a vote of 220 Yeas and 207 Nays.

- August 16, 2022—H.R. 5376, the *Inflation Reduction Act of 2022*, was signed by President Biden and became Public Law No. 117-169.

## Committee Letters

The Committee sent the following letters in August:

- August 4, 2022—Letter to the Honorable Gene Dodaro, Comptroller General of the United States, requesting that the Government Accountability Office (GAO) study the factors that impact access to health insurance coverage for college students. This was a joint letter with Senate Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions Chair Patty Murray.
- August 5, 2022—Letter to the Honorable Joseph R. Biden, Jr., President of the United States, extending support for his Administration's plans to engage in rulemaking with regard to the *Equal Participation of Faith-Based Organizations in the Federal Agencies' Programs and Activities* final rules for nine departments and agencies.
- August 9, 2022—Letter to the Honorable Miguel Cardona, U.S. Secretary of Education, requesting additional information about the actions the Department is taking to hold owners, executives, and board members of for-profit and converted non-profit institutions of higher education accountable and personally liable, specifically regarding institutions that have had borrower's defense claims approved by the Department, including in the *Sweet v. Cardona* settlement, and that continue to operate.
- August 10, 2022—Letter to the Honorable Miguel Cardona, U.S. Secretary of Education, providing comments on a Notice for Proposed Rulemaking on seven topics: borrower's defense to repayment, pre-dispute arbitration and class action waivers, interest capitalization, closed school discharge, total and permanent disability discharge, false certification discharge, and public service loan forgiveness.
- August 25, 2022—Letter to the Honorable Miguel Cardona, U.S. Secretary of Education, providing comments on a Notice for Proposed Rulemaking on three topics: prison education programs, closing the 90/10 loophole, and institutional conversions.
