COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

July 2022

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. Notwithstanding the disruption to normal operations resulting from the coronavirus pandemic, the Committee conducted its regular advisory and investigative functions via telework in July 2022. The Committee received 20 requests for advisory opinions in July 2022.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 117th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 283 new travel requests in July 2022 for travel beginning in June or later. In addition, 144 House travelers went on a privately-sponsored, officially connected trip within the month of June that the Committee previously approved.

In addition, the Committee is required under House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees. New Members, officers, and employees must receive training no later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in July of 2022. The Committee continued to provide training online and through a number of training videos. Additional information about the calendar of upcoming training opportunities is available on the Committee's website at https://ethics.house.gov/.

In July 2022, the Committee issued a summary of its activities for June 2022 directed to the Committee on House Administration. This statement is publicly available on the Committee on House Administration's website.

The Committee released four public statements in July 2022 regarding Representatives Judy Chu, Pat Fallon, Chris Jacobs, Thomas Suozzi, Andy Levin, and the arrests of Members outside of the House during a protest outside the Supreme Court.
