**Chairman Frank Pallone, Jr., Subcommittee Chairs and other House and Senate Leaders**

**October 1, 2020** – Chairman Pallone along with Subcommittee on Health Chairwoman, Anna Eshoo and Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations Chair, Diana DeGette sent a letter to Chad Wolf, Acting Secretary of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security regarding whistleblower complaint for lack of medical care for immigrants in Irwin County Detention Center in Ocilla, Georgia.

**October 6, 2020** – Chairman Pallone and Rep. Bobby Scott, Chairman of the Committee on Education and Labor sent letters to Hon. Alex M. Azar, Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and Hon. Eugene Scalia, Secretary of the Department of Labor (DOL) demanding increased protections for nation’s frontline workers as COVID-19 pandemic continues.

**October 7, 2020** – Chairman Pallone and Subcommittee on Consumer Protection and Commerce Chairwoman, Jan Schakowsky sent a letter to Jeff Bezos, CEO and Chairman of Amazon regarding product safety issues with AmazonBasics’ popular electronic products.

**October 7, 2020** – Chairman Pallone along with Subcommittee on Health Chairwoman, Anna Eshoo and Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations Chair, Diana DeGette, sent letter to Hon. Alex M. Azar II, Secretary of Health and Human Services (HHS) raising concerns over his decision to overrule career scientists at the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to allow laboratory developed tests to come to the market including COVID-19 tests without FDA review.

**October 7, 2020** – Chairman Pallone sent a letter to Mark Meadows White House Chief of Staff regarding the White House outbreak of COVID-19 and not working with the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) to contract trace.

**October 9, 2020** – Chairman Pallone, Ranking Member Walden, Subcommittee on Oversight Investigations Chair, Diana DeGette and Ranking Member of Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations, Brett Guthrie sent a letter to Gene Dodaro, Comptroller General of the United States, Government Accountability Office (GAO) requesting that GAO evaluate HHS cybersecurity response capabilities involving threats and data breaches.

**October 9, 2020** – Chairman Pallone along with Subcommittee on Communications and Technology Chairman, Mike Doyle sent a letter to Adam Candeub, Acting Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Communications and Information, National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA) regarding NTIA management of the federal spectrum uses. They expressed concern over the Department of Defense (DOD) attempts to usurp NTIA authority to own and operate a National 5G network and lease federal spectrum.

**October 9, 2020** – Chairman Pallone along with Subcommittee on Communications and Technology Chairman, Mike Doyle sent letter to Gene Dodaro, Comptroller General of the United States, Government Accountability Office (GAO) requesting GAO evaluate whether DOD has the legal authority to construct, operate or maintain a commercial communications network or lease its electromagnetic spectrum to private entities.

**October 13, 2020** – Chairman Pallone and Rep. Richard Neal, Chairman of the Committee on Ways and Means sent a letter to Hon. Steven Mnuchin, Secretary of the U.S. Department of Treasury regarding the decision by the Department of Treasury to continue to withhold funds for the New York Fire Department World Trade Center health program.

**October 13, 2020** – Chairman Pallone, along with Rep. Richard Neal, Chairman of the Committee on Ways and Means, and Ron Wyden, Ranking Member on the Senate Finance Committee sent a letter to Gene Dodaro, Comptroller General, United States Government Accountability Office to conduct review of Trump Administration plan to send Medicare beneficiaries a prescription drug card for use towards copays.

**October 13, 2020** – Chairman Pallone, along with Rep. Richard Neal, Chairman of the Committee on Ways and Means, and Senator Ron Wyden, Ranking Member on the Senate Finance Committee sent a letter to Hon. Alex M. Azar II, Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) regarding the legality of the Trump Administration plan to send \$200 “Trump Cards” to Medicare beneficiaries ahead of election day.

**October 15, 2020** – Chairman Pallone and Subcommittee on Consumer Protection and Commerce Chairwoman, Jan Schakowsky sent a letter to Hon. Joseph Simons, Chairman of the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) regarding rulemaking for Made in USA labeling of American made products.

**October 21, 2020** – Chairman Pallone, and Rep. Richard Neal, Chairman of the Committee on Ways and Means sent a letter to Hon. Seema Verna, Administrator for Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) regarding CMS proposal to modify the regulating framework that currently limits the expansion of Physician Owned Hospitals (POH).

**October 23, 2020** – Chairman Pallone, Subcommittee on Health Chairwoman, Anna Eshoo, and Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations Chair, Diana DeGette, sent a letter to Hon. Alex M. Azar II regarding family separations of 545 children whose parents have not been located and what actions the Administration is taking to locate the parents.

**October 28, 2020** – Chairman Pallone and Subcommittee on Communications and Technology Chairman, Mike Doyle, sent a letter to Hon. Ajit Pai, Chairman of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) regarding the FCC role in interpreting Section 230 of the Communications Decency Act (CDA 230).

**October 30, 2020** – Chairman Pallone, along with Subcommittee on Communications and Technology Chairman, Mike Doyle and Subcommittee on Consumer Protection and Commerce Chairwoman, Jan Schakowsky sent a letter to Mark Zuckerberg, CEO of Facebook, asking him to work with New York University researchers studying the platform’s political advertising.

During the month of October, the Committee on Energy and Commerce staff, at the direction of the Chairman and its members, worked on developing and providing the best tools to enable its members to safely convene and work together on the important issues under the Committee's jurisdiction.
