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# **MEMORANDUM**

To: Members, Committee on House Administration From: Committee Staff Re: Full Committee Hearings: Part 1 and 2 "Committee Funding for the 118<sup>th</sup> Congress"

### On Tuesday, February 28, 2023 at 10:10a.m. E.T, and Wednesday, March 1, 2023 at

**9:00a.m. E.T.**, the Committee on House Administration (CHA) will hold hearings on funding requests for all the Standing and Select Committees of the 118<sup>th</sup> Congress, excluding the Appropriations Committee. Each Committee Chair and Ranking Member will come before CHA to justify their biennial funding request and answer questions CHA Members may have regarding the budget requests.

#### **Background**

Pursuant to House Rule X, Clause 6, committees are funded on a biennial basis at the beginning of each Congress. Each Standing and Select Committee of the House, excluding Appropriations, must submit a biennial funding request for both sessions of the Congress to CHA and introduce a primary expense resolution providing amounts for the expenses of the committee for that Congress. All committee expense resolutions will be combined in an omnibus primary expense resolution that will be marked up at CHA and reported to the House for floor consideration.

In an accompanying report, CHA is required to provide: the total funding provided to each committee for their respective programs and activities; as well as general statements on the estimated foreseeable expenditures for each committee's programs and activities in order to provide basic information about overall expenditures contemplated by the primary expense resolution.<sup>1</sup>

#### **Committee Funding Requests**

On January 20, 2023, the Committee on House Administration sent letters to committee chairs requesting that they submit their budget request by Monday, February 13, 2023. Committees were asked to provide a breakdown of anticipated expenditures including personnel compensation, travel, communications, printing and production, consultant contracts, detailees, training, service contracts, supplies, equipment and software. In addition, committees were asked to complete a questionnaire.
