#### **COMMITTEE ON ETHICS**

#### September 2015

The Committee continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct.<sup>1</sup> As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. The Committee received 20 requests for advisory opinions in September of 2015. Advisory materials the Committee has publicly released are available on the Committee's Web site at <u>http://ethics.house.gov/</u>.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 114<sup>th</sup> Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received 199 such requests in September of 2015.

In addition, the Committee is required under House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees. New Members, officers, and employees must receive training no later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in September of 2015. The Committee provided live training sessions attended by 116 individuals in September of 2015. The Committee also continued to provide training online and through a number of training videos. Additional information about the calendar of upcoming in-person training sessions and online training opportunities is available on the Committee's Web site at <a href="http://ethics.house.gov/">http://ethics.house.gov/</a>.

The Committee released two public statements in September of 2015. The first was released September 3, 2015 regarding the matter of Representative Mike Honda. The second was released September 28, 2015 regarding the matter of Representative Blake Farenthold.
