COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

February 2023

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. In February 2023, the Committee responded to nearly 1,500 phone calls and email messages seeking advice, and participated in many informal meetings with Members, House staff, and outside individuals or groups regarding specific ethics matters. The Committee also received 13 requests for formal advisory opinions.

The Committee held its organizational meeting on February 28, 2023. The Committee provided public notice and granted public access to this meeting. The Committee also adopted rules for the current Congress during that portion of the meeting that was open to the public.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 118th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officiallyconnected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 166 new travel requests in February 2023 for travel beginning in February or later. One hundred and forty-eight House travelers went on a privately-sponsored, officially-connected trip within the month of February.

The Committee is required under House rules to offer mandatory annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. The Committee is working to modernize its guidance in both substance and method of delivery. Additionally, 113 individuals attended live, virtual, or in-person training provided by the Committee, provided at the request of four offices and committees. One hundred and two individuals attended the live in-person training hosted by the Committee on February 24. The calendar of live training opportunities is available <u>here</u>.

As part of a Committee-wide effort to better promote compliance through clear and effective guidance, the Committee issued a Pink Sheet detailing the 2023 Outside Earned Income Limit and Salaries Triggering the Financial Disclosure Requirement and Post-Employment Restrictions Applicable to House Officers and Employees. The Financial Disclosure Requirement and Post-Employment Restrictions Pink Sheet is available <u>here</u>. Prior general advisories and pink sheets are available <u>here</u>.

The Committee issued a summary of its activities for January 2023 directed to the Committee on House Administration. This statement is publicly available on the Committee on House Administration's website.
