118th Congress Activities Report
February 2023

Full Committee Hearings:

February 9, 2023: Full Committee Hearing, “The Looking Ahead Series: The Architect of the Capitol’s Strategic Plan for the 118th Congress.” Witness testimony from Honorable J. Brett Blanton, Architect of the Capitol.

- Witness: Brett Blanton, Architect of the Capitol
- Outcome, Takeaways: This hearing exposed the Architect’s unethical use of his official vehicle and lack of willingness to take responsibility for his action. The hearing highlighted his lacking management skills and failure to initiate responsible behavior as the leader of the AOC.
- Results: The accountability brought to light by the hearings resulted in President Biden removing Blanton as Architect of the Capitol. Chere Rexroat, Chief Engineer of the AOC, was appointed Acting AOC on February 13th.
- Submitted QFRs to Acting AOC Rexroat

Oversight Activities:

- Re-established accountability for the Architect of the Capitol, resulting in a change of leadership for the institution.
- Laying the groundwork for an aggressive, engaging schedule of oversight hearings on both the full committee and subcommittee levels.
- Continuing to build relationships, communicate priorities, and gain a deeper understanding of the strategic plans across House entities.
- Drove conversations for increasing access to campus and staffers' utilization of resources. Continued to hold entities accountable for increased customer service and overall improvement in the service levels across campus.
 - Four points of progress: (1) CVC open to the public for Saturday tours beginning Saturday March 4th. (2) OAP fee structure modernization. (3) Driving CAO and AOC to reimagine the utilization of space to better serve the modern House. (4) Clerk released updated Congressional Directory with requested expansion/return of the "Miscellaneous" Section

- Working with the CAO to ensure the trainings available (or in the development stage) for staff meets the needs of the audiences.
- Ensuring that committee needs are represented in discussions on the Hearing Room Renovation Program and that the AOC and CAO are held accountable for delivery. This includes making decisions regarding the Longworth Rack Room consolidation initiative.
- Successfully coordinated with the USCP and HSAA for the State of the Union Address that took place on February 7, 2023
 - Partnered with the House Recording Studio to authorize expanded camera angles and perspective shots to further “open the Floor” to the American people to see their government in action.
- Partnered with the GPO to ensure proper management and action in the wake of the PII leak caused by the January 6 Select Committee’s final report.
- Began development of a portal through which to accept and process Americans’ concerns, stories, insights, suggestions, etc. regarding the events on January 6, 2021 and the committee’s intent to conduct thorough oversight of the security failures that occurred that day.
- Partnered with the newly appointed Republican Smithsonian Regents to offer support throughout their service in this role.
- Partnered with the Clerk to formalize a protocol for onboarding Special Election Winners to ensure that all Members are onboarded successfully and provided tools to operate effectively.
- Approved the House IG’s Annual Plan. This is the earliest the annual plan has been approved by the committee in 14 years, putting into motion the IG’s work to fight fraud, waste, and abuse.
- Partnered with the CAO to rapidly respond to a concern on campus regarding QR codes. Worked with CAO executive team and HIR to draft an e Dear Colleague reminding staff and Members to be cautious when considering using QR codes on their work devices.
