COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

January 2021

The activities of the Committee on Ethics (Committee) in January 2021 spanned the 116th Congress, which ended on January 3, 2021, and the 117th Congress, which began the same day. In the 116th Congress, the Committee was led by Chairman Theodore E. Deutch and Ranking Member Kenny Marchant. In the 117th Congress, the Committee will be led by Chairman Theodore E. Deutch and Ranking Member Jackie Walorski.

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct.¹ As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. Notwithstanding the disruption to normal operations resulting from the coronavirus pandemic, the Committee conducted its regular advisory and investigative functions via telework in January 2021. The Committee received 26 requests for advisory opinions in January 2021.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 117th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officiallyconnected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 40 new travel requests in January 2021 for travel beginning in January or later. In addition, no House travelers went on a privatelysponsored, officially connected trip within the month of January that the Committee previously approved.

In addition, the Committee is required under House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees. New Members, officers, and employees must receive training no later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in January of 2021. The Committee continued to provide training online and through a number of training videos. In January 2021, the Committee issued a summary of its activities for December 2020 directed to the Committee on House Administration. This statement is publicly available on the Committee on House Administration's website.
