## COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

### March 2023

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. In March 2023, the Committee responded to nearly 1,800 phone calls and email messages seeking advice, and participated in many informal meetings with Members, House staff, and outside individuals or groups regarding specific ethics matters. The Committee also received 16 requests for formal advisory opinions.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 118<sup>th</sup> Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 321 new travel requests in March 2023 for travel beginning in March or later. Two hundred and fourteen House employees traveled on a Committee-approved, privately-sponsored, officially-connected trip within the month of March.

The Committee is required under House rules to offer mandatory annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. The Committee is working to modernize its guidance in both substance and method of delivery. The Committee continued to provide training in March through live and on-demand offerings. Sixty-five individuals attended the live in-person training hosted by the Committee on March 27. Thirty individuals also attended live virtual or in-person training provided by the Committee at the request of two offices and committees.
