### **COMMITTEE ON ETHICS**

### **April 2024**

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. In April 2024, the Committee responded to over 1,600 phone calls and email messages seeking advice, and participated in many informal meetings with Members, House staff, and outside individuals or groups regarding specific ethics matters. The Committee also received 41 requests for formal advisory opinions.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 118<sup>th</sup> Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 182 new travel requests in April 2024 for travel beginning in April or later. One hundred and seventy-seven House employees traveled on a Committee-approved, privately-sponsored, officially-connected trip within the month of April.

The Committee is required under House rules to offer mandatory annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. The Committee is working to modernize its guidance in both substance and method of delivery. The Committee continued to provide training in April through live and on-demand offerings. Twenty individuals attended the live, in-person Ethics training hosted by the Committee on April 12. Fifteen individuals also attended the live virtual training at the request of two offices. Sixty-six individuals attended two hybrid live Financial Disclosure trainings hosted by the Committee on April 18 and April 23. The calendar of live in-person training opportunities is available <u>here</u>.

As part of a Committee-wide effort to better promote compliance through clear and effective guidance, the Committee issued its 2024 Instruction Guide for Financial Disclosure Statements for Calendar Year 2023 Reporting Period and Periodic Transaction Reports on April 12. In addition to the 2024 Instruction Guide, the Committee issued two General Advisories in April, including a notice of Upcoming Financial Disclosure Clinics & Training and a Revised Legal Expense Fund Regulations. The Committee hosted two Financial Disclosure clinics for Members and House staff on April 18 and April 23. The 2024 Financial Disclosure Instruction Guide is available here. The Upcoming Financial Disclosure Clinics & Trainings can be found here. The Revised Legal Expense Fund Regulations can be found here. Prior general advisories and pink sheets are available here.
