Chairman Frank Pallone, Jr., Subcommittee Chairs and other House and Senate Leaders

August 5, 2020 – Chairman Pallone and Ranking Member Walden, along with Senator Roger Wicker, Chairman and Senator Maria Cantwell, Ranking Member of the Senate Committee on Commerce, Science and Transportation sent a joint letter to Wilbur Ross, Secretary of the Department of Commerce (DOC) and Joseph J. Simons, Chairman of the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) regarding the recent decision by European Court of Justice that invalidated one of the mechanisms for allowing transfer of personal data from European Union to the United States, the EU-US Privacy Shield Framework.

August 5, 2020 – Chairman Pallone and Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations Chair Diana DeGette sent a letter to Deborah Birx, M.D. Coronavirus Task Force Coordinator, and Alex M. Azar II, Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) regarding the COVID-19 vaccine distribution plan.

August 7, 2020 – Chairman Pallone sent a letter to Charles Jones, Jr., President and CEO of FirstEnergy and James Fakult, President of Jersey Central Power and Light regarding the abysmal response of Jersey Central Power and Light and FirstEnergy to threat and aftermath of Tropical Storm Isaias.

August 11, 2020 – Subcommittee on Health Chairwoman, Anna Eshoo and Ranking Member, Michael Burgess and Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations Chair Diana DeGette and Ranking Member Brett Guthrie sent a letter to Alex M. Azar II, Secretary of Health and Human Services regarding drug overdose crisis during COVID-19 pandemic.

August 11, 2020 – Chairman Pallone along with Subcommittee on Health Chairwoman, Anna Eshoo, and Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations Chair Diana DeGette, wrote a letter to Robert Redfield, M.D., Director of the Center for Disease Control regarding impacts of COVID-19 on children.

August 13, 2020 – Subcommittee on Health Chairwoman, Anna Eshoo and Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations Chair, Diana DeGette, along with other Members of the Committee, Darren Soto, Tom O'Halleran, G.K. Butterfield, Doris O. Matsui, Peter Welch, Ben Ray Lujan, and Tony Cardenas sent a joint letter to Ajit V. Pai, Chairman of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) regarding providing unlimited voice and data plans to Lifeline recipients.

August 13, 2020 – Chairman Pallone, Subcommittee on Health Chairwoman, Anna Eshoo, and Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations Chair, Diana DeGette sent oversight letter to nine health insurance and dental insurance companies today seeking information on their policies and practices amid COVID-19 pandemic: President and CEO of Anthem, Gail Boudreaux; President and CEO of Cigna, David Cordani; President and CEO of CVS Health, Larry J. Merlo; President and CEO of Humana, Bruce D. Broussard; CEO of UnitedHealth, David S. Wichman; President and CEO of Delta Dental, Steven R. Olson; CEO of Guardian, Deanna M. Mulligan; President and CEO of MetLife, Michel A. Khalaf; and President and CEO of United Concordia Dental, Timothy J. Constantine. The letters asked nine questions regarding insurers COVID-19 profits, testing, and financial assistance to enrollees and employers and asked for answers due by August 27, 2020.

August 19, 2020 – Chairman Pallone, Subcommittee on Health Chairwoman, Anna Eshoo and Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations Chair, Diana DeGette wrote to Gene Dodaro, Comptroller General of the United States, Government Accountability Office (GAO) requesting GAO initiate a review of HHS decision to change hospital reporting requirements during COVID-19 pandemic, and report findings to the Committee.

August 19, 2020 – Chairman Pallone and Subcommittee on Communications and Technology Chairman Mike Doyle sent a letter to Ajit V. Pai, Chairman of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) requesting FCC to bring high speed internet service to rural tribal land giving tribes more time to apply for license in 2.5 GHz Band.

August 20, 2020 – Chairman Pallone, Subcommittee on Health Chairwoman, Anna Eshoo and Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations Chair, Diana DeGette, wrote to Gene Dodaro, Comptroller General of the United States, Government Accountability Office (GAO) requesting to be added as Co-requestors on GAO Review of FDA oversight of lab safety.

August 21, 2020 – Chairman Pallone, Subcommittee on Health Chairwoman, Anna Eshoo, and Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations Chair, Diana DeGette, sent oversight letters to 7 companies into the impact of Postal Service changes on Prescription Drug Deliveries: President and CEO of CVS Health, Larry J. Merlo; President of Express Scripts and Cigna Services, Tim Wentworth; President and CEO of National Association of Chain Drug Stores, Steven C. Anderson; CEO of OptumRx, John Prince; President and CEO of Pharmaceutical Care Management Association, J.C. Scott; President and CEO of Rite Aid Corporation, Heyward Donigan; President of Walgreens, Alex Gourlay. The letters asked for information on mail-order delivery services of prescription drugs and for answers by September 11, 2020.

August 24, 2020 – Chairman Pallone, Subcommittee on Health Chairwoman, Anna Eshoo, and Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations Chair, Diana DeGette wrote to Stephen Hahn, M.D., Commissioner of the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) regarding efforts to prevent political pressure affecting vaccine approval process.
