Chairman Frank Pallone, Jr., Subcommittee Chairs, and other House and Senate Leaders

October 3, 2022 – Chairman Pallone along with, Chairman Richard E. Neal of the Ways and Means Committee; and Chairman Robert C. “Bobby” Scott of the Education and Labor Committee wrote to Hon. Xavier Becerra, Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), in support of the Biden’s Administration proposed Health Care nondiscrimination rule.

October 6, 2022 – Speaker Nancy Pelosi along with Chairman Pallone wrote a letter to Hon. Jessica Rosenworcel, Chairwoman of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), expressing concerns about the proposed acquisition of TEGNA, a broadcast news company that manages 64 stations across 51 domestic markets.

Watson, President and CEO of Comcast Cable Communications LLC; Thomas Rutledge, Chairman and CEO of Charter Communications, Inc.; Dennis Mathew, CEO of Altice USA, Inc.; and Mark Greatrex, President of Cox Communications, Inc., regarding concerns over providers in abusive, misleading, fraudulent or otherwise predatory behaviors through Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB) program and the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP).
