COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

<u>October 2021</u>

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. Notwithstanding the disruption to normal operations resulting from the coronavirus pandemic, the Committee conducted its regular advisory and investigative functions via telework in October 2021. The Committee received 13 requests for advisory opinions in October 2021.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 117th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 122 new travel requests in October 2021 for travel beginning in October or later. In addition, 303 House travelers went on a privately-sponsored, officially connected trip within the month of October that the Committee previously approved.

In addition, the Committee is required under House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees. New Members, officers, and employees must receive training no later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in October of 2021. The Committee continued to provide training online and through a number of training videos. Additional information about the calendar of upcoming training opportunities is available on the Committee's website at https://ethics.house.gov/.

In October 2021, the Committee issued a summary of its activities for September 2021 directed to the Committee on House Administration. This statement is publicly available on the Committee on House Administration's website.

The Committee released nine public statements in October 2021 regarding Representatives John Sample, Jim Hagedorn, Mike Kelly, Tom Malinowski, Alex Mooney, Andrew Clyde, Dan Crenshaw, Marjorie Taylor-Greene, and Bill Huizenga.
