#### ACTIVITIES OF THE COMMITTEE ON SMALL BUSINESS 112<sup>TH</sup> CONGRESS, 1<sup>ST</sup> SESSION

#### MARCH 2011 FULL COMMITTEE HEARINGS & MARK-UPS

March 2, 2011: "The Small Business Administration FY 2012 Budget." The purpose of the hearing was to examine the FY 2012 budget request for the Small Business Administration. The information garnered at this hearing was utilized in the Committee's development of views and estimates that was submitted to the Budget Committee.

March 16, 2011: "Spurring Innovation and Job Creation: The SBIR Program." This hearing marked the beginning of the Committee's work to reauthorize the SBIR program. Last fully reauthorized in 2000, the SBIR program is an effective way to jump start entrepreneurs, grow our economy, and create jobs. This hearing provided members with an opportunity to learn more about this important program and was the first in a series of Committee meetings aimed at fully examining the SBIR program before introducing reauthorizing legislation.

March 30, 2011: "Reducing Federal Agency Overreach: Modernizing the Regulatory Flexibility Act." The purpose of the hearing was to examine the Regulatory Flexibility Act (RFA) as amended by the Small Business Regulatory Enforcement Fairness Act. The hearing laid the foundation for future Committee consideration of RFA reform and agency compliance with the Act.
