COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

February 2021

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. Notwithstanding the disruption to normal operations resulting from the coronavirus pandemic, the Committee conducted its regular advisory and investigative functions via telework in February 2021. The Committee received 40 requests for advisory opinions in February 2021.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 117th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officiallyconnected travel. The Committee received and reviewed one new travel request in February 2021 for travel beginning in February or later. In addition, 41 House travelers went on a privatelysponsored, officially connected trip within the month of February that the Committee previously approved.

On February 25, 2021, the Committee: held its organizational meeting; provided public notice of that meeting; granted public access to the meeting virtually through the Committee's website; and adopted rules for the current Congress during that portion of the meeting that was opened to the public.

As discussed during the public portion of the organizational meeting, the Committee's nonpartisan staff carefully reviewed the Committee's rules from last Congress, and recommended no substantive changes to those rules. Accordingly, the Committee did not adopt any substantive changes to its rules for the 117th Congress. The Committee has made its rules publicly available on its website and submitted them for publication in the Congressional Record.

In addition, the Committee is required under House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees. New Members, officers, and employees must receive training no later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in February of 2021. The Committee continued to provide training online and through a number of training videos. Additional information about the calendar of upcoming training opportunities is available on the Committee's website at https://ethics.house.gov/.

In February 2021, the Committee issued a summary of its activities for January 2021 directed to the Committee on House Administration. This statement is publicly available on the Committee on House Administration's website.
