H.R. 8656, “To provide for the implementation of certain recommendations from the Report of the Wildland Fire Mitigation and Management Commission” was introduced by Rep. Josh Harder and referred to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology.

H.R. 8665, “To amend the Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007 to direct research, development, demonstration, and commercial application activities in support of supercritical geothermal and closed-loop geothermal systems in supercritical various conditions, and for other purposes” was introduced by Rep. Frank Lucas and referred to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology.
