- H. Con. Res. 19, Authorizing the use of the Capitol Grounds for the Greater Washington Soap Box Derby. Passed under Suspension by a record vote of 386 yeas and 0 nays (Roll No. 157).
- H.R. 1311, To amend the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act to ensure that unmet needs after a major disaster are met. Passed under Suspension by a record vote of 329 yeas and 56 nays (Roll No. 158).
