COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

<u>April 2025</u>

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. In April, the Committee responded to nearly 1,500 phone calls and email messages seeking advice, and participated in many informal meetings with Members, House staff, and outside individuals or groups regarding specific ethics matters. The Committee also received 47 requests for formal advisory opinions.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 119th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 190 new travel requests in April 2025 for travel beginning in April or later. Three hundred and twenty-three employees traveled on a Committee-approved, privately-sponsored, officially-connected trip within the month of April.

The Committee is required under House rules to offer mandatory annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. The Committee is working to modernize its guidance in both substance and method of delivery. The Committee continued to provide training in April through live and on-demand offerings. Eighteen individuals attended the live, in-person Ethics training hosted by the Committee on April 28. Twenty-one individuals attended the live, in-person Ethics training at the request of two offices. Thirty-nine individuals also attended three hybrid live Financial Disclosure trainings on April 15, April 23, and April 28. The calendar of live in-person training opportunities is available here.

As part of an effort to promote compliance through clear and effective guidance, the Committee issued its 2025 Instruction Guide for Financial Disclosure Statements for Calendar Year 2024 Reporting Period and Periodic Transaction Reports on April 28. In addition to the 2025 Instruction Guide, the Committee issued a Pink Sheet detailing Upcoming Financial Disclosure Clinics and Training on April 14. The 2025 Financial Disclosure Instruction Guide is available here. The Pink Sheet on Upcoming Financial Disclosure Clinics and Training can be found here.
