COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

July 2013

The Committee continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. (An enumeration of those laws and rules as they stood at the end of the 112th Congress is found in H. Rep. 112-739, *Summary of Activities, One Hundred Twelfth Congress, A Report of the Committee on Ethics*, 112th Cong., 2d Sess. (December 31, 2012).) As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. The Committee received 45 requests for advisory opinions in July of 2013. Advisory materials the Committee has publicly released are available on the Committee's Web site, at http://ethics.house.gov/.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives of the 113th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received 320 such requests in July of 2013.

In addition, the Committee is required under the House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees, and new officers or employees must receive training not later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in July of 2013. The Committee provided live training sessions attended by 149 individuals in July of 2013. The Committee also continued to provide training online, through a number of training videos. Additional information about the calendar of upcoming in-person training sessions and online training opportunities is available on the Committee's Web site, at http://ethics.house.gov/.

The Committee released one general advisory report in July of 2013. The Committee released a general advisory report on July 24, titled *Notice With Regard to Financial Disclosure of Spouse Assets*, which provided guidance for the reporting of spouse assets on financial disclosure statements. General advisories are available on the Committee's Web site, at http://ethics.house.gov/.

The Committee released five public statements regarding investigative matters in July of 2013. Chairman K. Michael Conaway and Ranking Member Linda T. Sánchez released five statements on July 26, 2013 regarding the handling of several matters referred to the Committee by the Office of Congressional Ethics.
