COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

June 2021

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. Notwithstanding the disruption to normal operations resulting from the coronavirus pandemic, the Committee conducted its regular advisory and investigative functions via telework in June 2021. The Committee received 22 requests for advisory opinions in June 2021.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 117th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 41 new travel requests in June 2021 for travel beginning in June or later. In addition, 160 House travelers went on a privately-sponsored, officially connected trip within the month of June that the Committee previously approved.

In addition, the Committee is required under House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees. New Members, officers, and employees must receive training no later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in June of 2021. The Committee continued to provide such training videos. In June 2021, the Committee issued a summary of its activities for May 2021 directed to the Committee on House Administration. This statement is publicly available on the Committee on House Administration's website.
