LETTERS

Chairman Frank Pallone, Jr. with Subcommittee Chairs and other House and Senate Leaders

February 6, 2020 – Chairman Pallone and Committee on the Judiciary Chairman Nadler sent a letter to Gene Dorado, the U.S. Comptroller General of the Government Accountability Office (GAO), regarding a GAO study of the public health and safety effects of fentanyl-related substances. In the letter, the Committee leaders express the hope that the GAO study will help inform Congress's consideration of criminal justice, health, and research issues for these substances, as the recently passed bill, S. 3201, extended the DEA's temporary placement of fentanyl-related substances on Schedule 1. The letter requests that the GAO consider five elements in this study to provide more information about fentanyl-related substances and the methods of control and investigation of this substance use.

February 25, 2020 – Chairman Pallone sent a letter to U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) Commissioner Stephen Hahn regarding the FDA's reconsideration of regulations that set a maximum level of nicotine in cigarettes to make them less addictive. Chairman Pallone expressed his concerns that the FDA is reconsidering these regulations, since they were recommended by the Commissioner's predecessor and could save lives based on a study that found enacting a regulation to lower nicotine content to minimally addictive levels would lead to a substantial reduction in tobacco-related mortality. The letter urges the Commissioner to rethink this decision and requests that by March 10, 2020, he provides answers to four questions that would allow the Committee to better understand the FDA's decision, its future thoughts, and other regulatory priorities to reduce tobacco-related disease and death.
