Chairman Frank Pallone, Jr., Subcommittee Chairs, and other House and Senate Leaders

August 3, 2022 – Chairman Pallone, wrote letters to Gretchen Watkins, President of Shell USA; Michael Wirth, Chairman and CEO of Chevron Corporation; Darren Woods, CEO of ExxonMobil; and David Lawler, Chairman and President of BP America regarding high gas prices and the companies’ record high profits and to ask what each company is doing to alleviate Americans’ pain at the pump.

August 4, 2022 – Chairman Pallone wrote the Honorable Robert M. Califf, Commissioner of U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) in support of the FDA proposed rule to prohibit menthol as a characterizing flavor in cigarettes and cigars

August 10, 2022 – Chairman Pallone along with Ranking Member Cathy McMorris Rodgers, Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations Chair Diana DeGette, Ranking Member Morgan Griffith, Subcommittee on Consumer Protection and Commerce Chair Jan Schakowsky, and Ranking Member Gus M. Bilirakis wrote letters to the Honorable Gina Raimondo, Secretary of U.S. Department of Commerce; Honorable Jennifer Granholm, Secretary of U.S. Department of Energy; Honorable Michael Regan, Administrator of Environmental Protection Agency; Honorable Xavier Becerra, Secretary of U.S. Department of Health and Human Services; and Honorable Alan Davidson, Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Communication and Technology, National Telecommunication and Information Administration requesting a briefing from each agency related to open-source software vulnerability – ApacheLog4j.

August 17, 2022 – Chairman Pallone along with Subcommittee on Energy Chairman Bobby L. Rush, Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations Chair Diana DeGette, and Subcommittee on Environment and Climate Change Chairman Paul Tonko sent letters to Mike Leavitt, CEO of Core Scientific; Fred Thiel, CEO of Marathon Digital Holdings; Jason Les, CEO of Riot Blockchain; and Gregory Beard, CEO of Stronghold Digital Mining regarding the oversight and energy impacts of block chain technology.

August 19, 2022 – Chairman Pallone along with Subcommittee on Environment and Climate Change Chairman Paul Tonko wrote to Honorable Michael S. Regan, Administrator of U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) urging the agency to complete the Drinking Water Infrastructure needs survey and assessment and incorporate the results into fiscal year 2023 Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) allocations.

August 23, 2022 – Chairman Pallone along with Chairman Bennie G. Thompson and Ranking Member John Katko of the Committee on Homeland Security; Ritchie Torres, Vice Chairman of the Committee on Homeland Security; and Michael Guest, Vice Ranking Member of the Committee on Homeland Security wrote to Honorable Christopher T. Hanson, Chairman of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, urging the agency to take immediate action to address vulnerabilities in its oversight purchases of radiological materials.
