- Friday, December 2, 2011—The Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests and Public Lands held a Legislative Hearing on H.R. 1237, to provide for a land exchange with the Trinity Public Utilities District of Trinity County, California, involving the transfer of land to the Bureau of Land Management and the Six Rivers National Forest in exchange for National Forest System land in the Shasta-Trinity National Forest, and for other purposes.
- **Friday, December 2, 2011**—The Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests and Public Lands held a Legislative Hearing on H.R. 2157, to facilitate a land exchange involving certain National Forest System lands in the Inyo National Forest, and for other purposes.
