COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

<u>May 2024</u>

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. In May, the Committee responded to over 2,600 phone calls and email messages seeking advice, and participated in many informal meetings with Members, House staff, and outside individuals or groups regarding specific ethics matters. The Committee also received 33 requests for formal advisory opinions.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 118th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 274 new travel requests in May 2024 for travel beginning in May or later. One hundred and seventy House employees traveled on a Committee-approved, privately-sponsored, officially-connected trip within the month of May.

The Committee is required under House rules to offer mandatory annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. The Committee is working to modernize its guidance in both substance and method of delivery. The Committee continued to provide training in May through live and on-demand offerings. Eighteen individuals attended the live, in-person Ethics training hosted by the Committee on May 10. Forty-nine individuals also attended the live virtual training at the request of two offices. Forty-five individuals attended one hybrid live Financial Disclosure training hosted by the Committee on May 2. The calendar of live in-person training opportunities is available <u>here</u>.

As part of an effort to better promote compliance through clear and effective guidance, the Committee, together with the Committee on House Administration and the Communications Standards Commission, issued a Pink Sheet detailing Joint Guidance Regarding Co-Sponsored Constituent Service Events. The Committee issued a Pink Sheet regarding Events Taking Place and Gifts Offered During a National Political Convention.
