### **Full Committee**

#### **January 3, 2025**

H.R. 108, the “Space Research Innovation Act” was introduced by Rep. Andy Biggs and referred to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology.

H.R. 112, the “FUEL Reform Act” was introduced by Rep. Andy Biggs and referred to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology.

H.R. 123, the “Improving Science in Chemical Assessments Act” was introduced by Rep. Andy Biggs and referred to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology.

H.R. 160, “To ensure election integrity and security and enhance Americans' access to the ballot box by establishing consistent standards and procedures for voter registration and voting in elections for Federal office, and for other purposes” was introduced by Rep. Brian Fitzpatrick and referred to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology.

H.R. 185, “To advance responsible policies” was introduced by Rep. James McGovern and referred to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology.

H.R. 191, “To repeal the Inflation Reduction Act of 2022” was introduced by Rep. Andrew Ogles and referred to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology.

H.R. 359, “To amend the Energy Policy Act of 2005 to require reporting relating to certain cost-share requirements, and for other purposes” was introduced by Rep. Jay Obernolte and referred to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology.

H.R. 390, “To utilize the Advanced Capabilities for Emergency Response to Operations project of NASA to improve aerial responses to wildfires, and for other purposes” was introduced by Rep. Vince Fong and referred to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology.

H.R. 420, “To impose limitations on the amount of indirect costs allowable under Federal research awards to institutions of higher education, and for other purposes” was introduced by Rep. Ben Cline and referred to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology.

H.R. 422, “To establish Federal research award reimbursement limits for indirect costs for institutions of higher education, and for other purposes” was introduced by Rep. Ben Cline and referred to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology.
