- **H.J. Res. 27,** Providing for congressional disapproval under chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code, of the rule submitted by the Department of the Army, Corps of Engineers, Department of Defense and the Environmental Protection Agency relating to "Revised Definition of 'Waters of the United States'", was ordered to be favorably reported to the House, without amendment, by a recorded vote of 30 yeas and 24 nays.
- **H.R. 1152,** the "Water Quality Certification and Energy Project Improvement Act of 2023", was agreed to and ordered to be favorably reported to the House, without amendment, by voice vote.
