During the month of April, the general administrative and legislative business of the Committee was conducted as usual.

Full Committee

On April 2, the committee held a hearing on “Keeping College within Reach: Meeting the Needs of Contemporary Students.”

On April 8, the committee held a markup on H.R. 4366, “Strengthening Education through Research Act,” which was ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, by voice vote. H.R. 10, “Success and Opportunity through Quality Charter Schools Act,” which was ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, by a vote of 36 yeas and 3 nays.

On April 9, the committee held a markup on H.R. 4321, “Employee Privacy Protection Act,” which was ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, by a vote of 21 yeas and 17 nays. H.R. 4320, “Workforce Democracy and Fairness Act,” which was ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, by a vote of 21 yeas and 14 nays.

On April 29, the committee held a hearing on “Reviewing the President’s Fiscal Year 2015 Budget Proposal for the Department of Education.”

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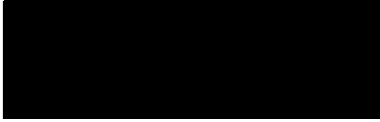
