H.R. 6605, to eliminate an unnecessary reporting requirement for an unfunded DNA Identification grant program, passed the House by a voice vote; under suspension of the rules, H.R. 6223, to amend section 1059(e) of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2006 to clarify that a period of employment abroad by the Chief of Mission or United States Armed Forces as a translator, interpreter, or in a security-related position in an executive or managerial capacity is to be counted as a period of residence and physical presence in the United States for purposes of qualifying for naturalization, and for other purposes, passed the House as amended by a voice vote; under suspension of the Rules, S. 3486, the "Patent Law Treaties Implementation Act of 2012", passed the House by a voice vote; and, under suspension of the Rules, S 2367, the "21st Century Language Act of 2012", passed the House by a roll call vote of 398 yeas to 1 nay, two-thirds required. December 18, 2012 - Under suspension of the Rules, H.R.6621, To correct and improve certain provisions of the Leahy-Smith America Invents Act and title 35, United States Code; passed the House by a roll call vote of 308 yeas to 89 nay two-thirds required. December 19, 2012 - Under suspension of the Rules, H.Res. 668, to refer H.R. 5862, a bill making congressional reference to the United States Court of Federal Claims pursuant to sections 1492 and 2509 of title 28, United States Code, the Indian trust-related claims

of the Quapaw Tribe of Oklahoma (O-Gah-Pah) as well as its individual members, passed the House by a roll call vote of 398 yeas to 5 nays, two-thirds required.

December 20, 2012 - Pursuant to the provisions of H.Res. 840, the House considered the conference report to accompany **H.R. 4310**, the "National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2013". This conference report included provisions of several bills under the Committee's jurisdiction.
