### COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

### **January 2022**

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. Notwithstanding the disruption to normal operations resulting from the coronavirus pandemic, the Committee conducted its regular advisory and investigative functions via telework in January 2022. The Committee received 21 requests for advisory opinions in January 2022.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 117<sup>th</sup> Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officiallyconnected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 141 new travel requests in January 2022 for travel beginning in January or later. In addition, 87 House travelers went on a privatelysponsored, officially connected trip within the month of January that the Committee previously approved.

In addition, the Committee is required under House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees. New Members, officers, and employees must receive training no later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in January of 2022. The Committee continued to provide training online and through a number of training videos.
