On May 17, the committee held a hearing on “Helping Students Succeed by Strengthening the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act.”

On May 18, the committee held a markup on H.J. Res. 87, Providing for congressional disapproval under chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code, of the final rule of the Department of Labor relating to "Interpretation of the 'Advice' Exemption in Section 203(c) of the Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act, which was ordered favorably reported to the House by 22 yeas and 13 nays. H.R. 5003, *Improving Child Nutrition and Education Act of 2016*, which was ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, by 20 yeas and 14 nays.

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
