A bill to require the disclosure of ownership of high-security space leased to accommodate a Federal agency, and for other purposes.

Passed the House, amended, under Suspension of the Rules by voice vote.

H.Res. 1145

Condemning the poisoning of Russian opposition leader Alexei Navalny and calling for a robust United States and international response.
