***FEBRUARY 2011 FULL COMMITTEE HEARINGS & MARK-UPS***

February 9, 2011: “Buried in Paperwork: A 1099 Update.” The Committee examined the expanded 1099 information reporting requirements in Section 9006 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act. The Committee heard testimony from small business owners about how the mandate will be an administrative burden and hinder job creation, growth and business investment. The Committee also heard testimony from Representative Daniel E. Lungren (R-CA), the sponsor of H.R. 4, *Small Business Paperwork Mandate Elimination Act of 2011*, which would repeal Section 9006 of the Act.

February 16, 2011: “Putting Americans Back to Work: The State of the Small Business Economy.” The Committee examined obstacles to small business job creation and economic growth and attempted to identify specific tax, regulatory and health care policies that are inhibiting job creation and economic growth. This hearing set the stage for future Committee debates on the most pertinent obstacles that are impeding entrepreneurs’ ability to strengthen our economy and put American back to work.
