March 22<sup>nd</sup>, the committee met to receive testimony from the Secretary of Defense, Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, and Comptroller, on the Department of Defense's Fiscal Year 2017 budget request, priorities, and key issues.

March 23<sup>rd</sup>, the committee met in a classified discussion with LTG Sean MacFarland about the priorities, key issues and challenges of Operation Inherent Resolve.


