- H.R. 1066, the “Wildfire Protection Act”. Was ordered to be reported to the House with a favorable recommendation, as amended, by a record vote of 61 yeas and 3 nays (Roll Call Vote No. 76).
- H.R. 4042, the “Aviation Funding Stability Fund Act of 2021” Was ordered to be reported to the House with a favorable recommendation, by a record vote of 58 yeas and 5 nays (Roll Call Vote No. 73).

- H.R. 5706, the “Stop Sexual Assault and Harassment in Transportation Act”. Was ordered to be reported to the House with a favorable recommendation, by voice vote.
