I am receipt of your July 28th response to my earlier letter concerning significant technical issues with ballot printers during the 2022 primary election in Clark County.


In response to your question, I have received detailed reports from voters and other observers that there were numerous printer malfunctions, causing significant delays for Clark County voters, at the following locations: Aliante Library, 7808 S. Torrey Pines Drive, and 215 Antelope Ridge Drive.

So, again I ask, in the interest of ensuring that voter confidence in our elections processes and outcomes is protected in the next federal election, please respond with an explanation of how your office will address service availability of printers and promptness of technicians, as well as any procedural or regulatory changes you will make to ensure these issues do not recur.

Regarding the logic and accuracy testing, you wrote that this testing did include printers. When did this testing occur, and were any of these issues that occurred with the printers detected at that time? With your response, please provide copies of any relevant public notices or postings describing this testing, as well as a description of the testing performed and the actual results achieved.
