COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

May 2023

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. In May 2023, the Committee responded to almost 2,500 phone calls and email messages seeking advice, and participated in many informal meetings with Members, House staff, and outside individuals or groups regarding specific ethics matters. The Committee also received 34 requests for formal advisory opinions.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 118th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 323 new travel requests in May 2023 for travel beginning in May or later. Three hundred and eleven House employees traveled on a Committee-approved, privately-sponsored, officially-connected trip within the month of May.

The Committee is required under House rules to offer mandatory annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. The Committee is working to modernize its guidance in both substance and method of delivery. The Committee continued to provide training in May through live and on-demand offerings. Ninety-seven individuals attended the live in-person Ethics training hosted by the Committee on May 19. Fifty-six individuals attended the hybrid live Financial Disclosure training hosted by the Committee on May 1. One hundred and twenty-three individuals also attended live virtual or in-person training provided by the Committee at the request of three offices and committees.
