## COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

### May 2022

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. Notwithstanding the disruption to normal operations resulting from the coronavirus pandemic, the Committee conducted its regular advisory and investigative functions via telework in May 2022. The Committee received 15 requests for advisory opinions in May 2022.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 117<sup>th</sup> Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 202 new travel requests in May 2022 for travel beginning in May or later. In addition, 220 House travelers went on a privately-sponsored, officially connected trip within the month of May that the Committee previously approved.

In addition, the Committee is required under House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees. New Members, officers, and employees must receive training no later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in May of 2022. The Committee continued to provide training online and through a number of training videos. In May 2022, the Committee issued a summary of its activities for April 2022 directed to the Committee on House Administration. This statement is publicly available on the Committee on House Administration's website.

The Committee released eight public statements in May 2022 regarding Representatives Ronny Jackson, Alex Mooney, Madison Cawthorn, Pat Fallon, Chris Jacobs, John Rutherford, and Andrew Clyde. Prior public statements are available on the Committee's website at <https://ethics.house.gov/>.

In May 2022, for the calendar year 2021 annual financial disclosure filing period, the Committee received 2,078 financial disclosure statements, 913 extension requests, and 99 candidate exemptions and withdrawals. Additionally, the Committee conducted 157 prescreens of draft financial disclosure statements.
