Josh Findlay currently serves as the first-ever National Director of Election Integrity for the Republican National Committee (RNC), where he is responsible for building the organization’s national Election Integrity infrastructure. During the 2022 Election Cycle, the RNC coordinated unprecedented Election Integrity efforts across 17 battleground states, including Governor Glenn Youngkin’s historic win in Virginia. The operation placed over 80,000 Republicans in official election roles and activated over 135,000 unique Election Integrity volunteers. Josh regularly speaks to national Republican and citizen groups on best practices for engaging in the electoral process and on the future of Election Integrity.

Previously, Josh served as legal counsel to President Donald J. Trump’s re-election campaign, where he ran the President’s national legal war room and served as a Senior Advisor to the President’s Election Integrity program. He also started the campaign’s Lawyers for Trump organization, growing membership to over 6,000 active attorneys by Election Day. Additionally, Josh’s national legal portfolio included presidential ballot access, national convention delegate elections, and Electoral College selection.

Prior to his service on the presidential campaign, Josh served as Chief Counsel to Congressman Jody Hice (GA-10) and had senior roles on numerous Gubernatorial, Senatorial, and Congressional campaigns. Before entering politics, Josh was a lawyer in private practice for five years at a firm in Georgia.
