Activities Report  
March 2017**

During the month of March, the general administrative and legislative business of the Committee was conducted as usual.

**Full Committee**

- On March 1, the Committee held a hearing on “Legislative Proposals to Improve Health Care Coverage and Provide Lower Costs for Families”; H.R. 1101, *Small Business Health Fairness Act*; Discussion Draft, the Self-Insurance Protection Act; and Discussion Draft, Preserving Employee Wellness Programs Act.
- On March 8, the Committee held a markup on H.R. 1304, *Self-Insurance Protection Act*; which was ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, by voice vote; H.R. 1101, *Small Business Health Fairness Act of 2017*; which was ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, by a vote of 22 yeas and 17 nays; and H.R. 1313, *Preserving Employee Wellness Programs Act*; which was ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, by a vote of 22 yeas and 17 nays.
- On March 16, the Committee held a hearing on “Honoring Our Commitment to Recover and Protect Missing and Exploited Children.”
