H.R. 1306, *Federal Disaster Assistance Coordination Act*.

To amend the Disaster Recovery Reform Act to develop a study regarding streamlining and consolidating information collection and preliminary damage assessments, and for other purposes. Passed the House under Suspension of the Rules, amended, by voice vote.

H.R. 1775, *Notice to Airmen Improvement Act of 2019*.

To establish a task force on NOTAM improvements, and for other purposes. Passed the House under Suspension of the Rules, without amendment by voice vote.

H.R. 2440, *Full Utilization of the Harbor Maintenance Trust Fund*.

To provide for the use of funds in the Harbor Maintenance Trust Fund for the purposes for which the funds were collected and to ensure that funds credited to the Harbor Maintenance Trust Fund are used to support navigation, and for other purposes. Passed the House under Suspension of the Rules, amended, by a 2/3 recorded vote of 296 yeas and 109 nays (Roll No. 585).

H.R. 2502, *Transparency in Federal Buildings Act of 2019*.

To amend title 40, United States Code, to require certain prospectuses for public buildings to be made publicly available, and for other purposes. Passed the House under Suspension of the Rules, without amendment, by voice vote.
