- On December 9, 2019, S. 256, the *Esther Martinez Native American Languages Programs Reauthorization Act*, passed the House by voice vote under suspension of the rules.

- On December 10, 2019, H.R. 5363, the *FUTURE Act*, passed the House by a vote of 319 Yeas and 96 Nays under suspension of the rules.
- On December 11, 2019, H.R. 5038, the *Farm Workforce Modernization Act of 2019*, passed the House by a vote of 260 Yeas and 165 Nays.
- On December 11, 2019, the conference report to accompany S. 1790, the *National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2020*, passed the House by a vote of 377 Yeas to 48 Nays.
- On December 12, 2019, H.R. 3, the *Elijah E. Cummings Lower Drug Costs Now Act of 2019*, passed the House by a vote of 230 Yeas and 192 Nays.
- On December 17, 2019, H.R. 1865, the *Further Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2020*, on the floor to resolve differences with House action on a motion that the House agree with an amendment to the Senate amendment, passed the House by a vote of 297 Yeas and 120 Nays.
