Dear Chairperson Lofgren and Ranking Member Davis,

Pursuant to Section 502 of House Resolution 756 from the 116th Congress, I am submitting this quarterly report about the Comparative Print Project.

As the Committee is aware, the Comparative Print Suite is a set of applications that allows House staff and others to create on-demand, point-in-time comparative prints between legislative texts and between legislative text and the law. My staff in Legislative Computer Systems (LCS), in partnership with the House Office of the Legislative Counsel (HOLC) and our contractors, lead the project team.

Since the last report, the project team deployed the Comparative Print Suite into the Clerk's cloud infrastructure, which improved the application's security and operations. We expect to transition the more-than-150 individual Committee Pilot Group users from the vendor space to the production environment at compare.house.gov during the week of October 17, 2022. Pilot Group users outside the House (Congressional Budget Office, Library of Congress, and Joint

Committee on Taxation) will continue to use the vendor space. Additionally, in partnership with the Congressional Staff Academy, we will complete development of the required training course the week of October 17, 2022. We expect to release the Comparative Print Suite House-wide the week of October 24, 2022.
