**Chairman Frank Pallone, Jr., Subcommittee Chairs and other House and Senate Leaders**

**March 8, 2022** – Chairman Pallone, along with Ranking Member Cathy McMorris Rodgers, Subcommittee on Health Chairwoman Anna Eshoo, and Ranking Member Brett Guthrie, and Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations Chair Diana DeGette and Ranking Member Morgan Griffith wrote to the Honorable Miriam E. Delphin-Rittman, Assistant Secretary for Mental Health and Substance Use, regarding the Biden Administration’s efforts to address the increased levels of mental health issues in the United States, given the impact of COVID-19.

**March 9, 2022** – Chairman Pallone along with Ranking Member Cathy McMorris Rodgers wrote to the Honorable Pete Buttigieg, Secretary of Transportation, requesting analysis by the DOT on Day Light Savings Time costs, benefits, and reasoning behind the policy.

**March 16, 2022** – Chairman Pallone sent letters to Scott Sheffield, CEO of Pioneer Natural Resources; Ben van Beurden, CEO of Royal Dutch Shell; Bernard Looney, CEO of BP; Michael Wirth, Chairman and CEO of Chevron Corporation; Rick Muncrief, President, and CEO of Devon Energy Corporation; and Darren Woods, CEO of Exxon Mobil expressing concern that the industry is taking advantage of the crisis in Ukraine and global markets shocks to keep prices artificially high. The executives were asked to testify at a hearing on April 6, 2022.

**March 21, 2022** – Chairman Pallone, along with Subcommittee on Energy Chairman Bobby Rush, and Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations Chair Diana DeGette wrote to John Ketchum, President and CEO of NextEra Energy; Tom Fanning, Chairman and CEO of Southern Company; Robert M. Blue, Chair, President and CEO of Dominion Energy; Jerry Norcia, President and CEO of DTE Energy; Lynn Good, Chair, President and CEO of Duke Energy; and Chris Crane, President and CEO of Exelon Corporation demanding answers for high customer shutoffs rates during COVID-19 pandemic.

**March 22, 2022** – Chairman Pallone wrote to John Lau, President, and CEO of 7 Daze; Patrick Beltran Co CEO of Puff Bar and Nick Minas, Co-CEO of Puff Bar; Eduard Kirakosyan, President, and CEO of Daddy’s Vapor Distro; and Troy Johnston, CEO of VaporSalon Vapor Lounge; to request information regarding health and safety at synthetic nicotine products that these companies sell including marketing to younger audiences.

**March 22, 2022** – Chairman Pallone, along with Ranking Member Cathy McMorris Rodgers, Subcommittee on Communications and Technology Chairman Mike Doyle and Ranking Member Robert E. Latta, wrote to the Honorable Jessica Rosenworcel, Chairwoman of Federal Communications Commission, regarding spectrum auction program.

**March 22, 2022** – Chairman Pallone wrote to the Honorable Chiquita Brooks-LaSure, Administrator for Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, requesting additional information on what actions CMS plans to take to ensure that all state Medicaid programs are in compliance with the requirement to cover abortion services in certain circumstances.
