- April 6, 2021—Letter to the Honorable Xavier Becerra, Secretary, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, encouraging the Department to announce the availability of a Special Enrollment Period (SEP) for qualified eligible individuals following the conclusion of the *American Rescue Plan Act*'s premium support program for job-based coverage. This was a joint letter with House Committee on Energy and Commerce Chair Frank Pallone, Jr., House Committee on Ways and Means Chair Richard Neal, Senate Committee on Health, Education Labor and Pensions Chair Patty Murray, and Senate Committee on Finance Chair Ron Wyden.
- April 12, 2021—Letter to the Honorable Marty Walsh, Secretary, U.S. Department of Labor, in support of the Department of Labor's proposal to withdraw the January 2021 final interpretive rule “Independent Contractor Status under the Fair Labor Standards Act.” This was a joint letter with 79 other Members of the U.S. House of Representatives.
- April 12, 2021—Letter to the Honorable Marty Walsh, Secretary, U.S. Department of Labor, in support of the Department of Labor's proposal to withdraw the January 2020 final interpretive rule “Joint Employer Status Under the Fair Labor Standards Act.” This was a joint letter with 84 other Members of the U.S. House of Representatives.
- April 16, 2021—Letter to the Honorable Gloria D. Steele, Acting Administrator, U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID), requesting that the agency suspend all pending actions related to the restructuring and redesign of USAID's Global Labor Program. This was a joint letter with House Committee on Foreign Relations Chair

Gregory Meeks, House Committee on Ways and Means Chair Richard Neal, and House Committee on Appropriations' Subcommittee on State and Foreign Operations Chair Barbara Lee.

- April 19, 2021—Letter to the Honorable JooYeun Chang, Acting Assistant Secretary, Administration for Children and Families, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, regarding congressional intent of Section 2204(c) of the *American Rescue Plan Act* that provides resources for “culturally specific community-based organizations.” This was a joint letter with Rep. Pramila Jayapal.
