All mail is processed at USPS Marketing Mail presort postage rates for the lowest postage costs. Priority Drop Ship Service is available to move time sensitive mailings more quickly.

Priority Drop Ship Service - This service will add an additional postage cost of 2-7 cents per piece.

NOTE:

- Mailing must consist of a minimum of 200 (qualifying) pieces for Marketing Mail Presort postage rates.
- All mail MUST have the Member's postNET barcode printed on lower left or the mail is sent at First Class rates.
- Offices sending more than 5,000 total mail pieces in a single day (1 mailing over 5,000 or 10 499 mailings) need to be scheduled one (1) week prior to mailing with House Postal Operations.
- Before you print out the addresses, Mailing Services 5-4355 can verify your mail list for free and you can save up to 25% off the postage by removing people who have moved and undeliverable addresses.
- Election Cut-Offs ALL Marketing Mail is processed and postmarked the following day.
